4 NEW ORLEANS to MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE: (2 nights) Travel north enroute to Memphis, the birthplace of the Blues, Rock 'n' Roll and Soul. Upon arrival immerse yourself in Memphis' energetic musical scene as you feast on southern cuisine on world-famous Beale Street. *Meals included: breakfast, dinner.*

5 MEMPHIS: This morning, embark on a one-of-a-kind tour of the city of Memphis. Local musicians board the coach and tell the story of Memphis' musical heritage and history as you view the city's many highlights... you may even be tempted to sing along! Then, don your blue suede shoes when you visit GRACELAND, the palatial home of Elvis Presley. Enter the 14-acre estate and visit his home, original business office, trophy building and Meditation Garden where Elvis and members of his family have been laid to rest. The balance of the evening is

free to enjoy the city's vast musical offerings on your own. Dance to the live music that may fill the open air or spend the evening exploring Beale Street's vibrant musical clubs! *Meals included: breakfast.*

6 MEMPHIS to NASHVILLE: (2 nights) Today travel to Nashville, the "Music Capital of the World". Your home for two nights will be the unique 2,881-room Gaylord Opryland Resort located adjacent to the Grand Ole Opry and the General Jackson Showboat. This evening, sit back and enjoy an evening at the GRAND OLE OPRY, the heart and soul of any Nashville visit. 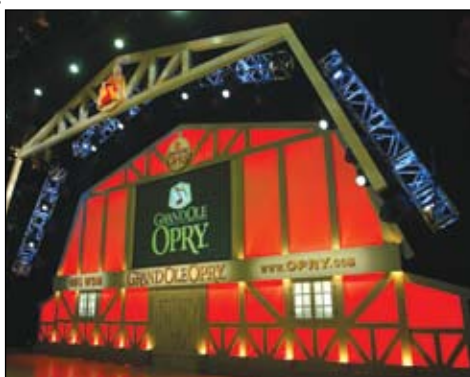

This afternoon, a local guide officially welcomes you to Nashville by sharing its history and lore during a fascinating sightseeing tour of Nashville. Visit the RYMAN AUDITORIUM before embarking on a panoramic tour of the city, highlighting the State Capitol, Music Row and the Parthenon – a full scale replica of the Athenian original! Tonight, enjoy a special dinner at the WILDHORSE SALOON, with its 3,300 square foot dance floor. *Meals included: breakfast, dinner.*
