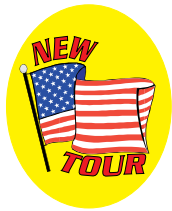

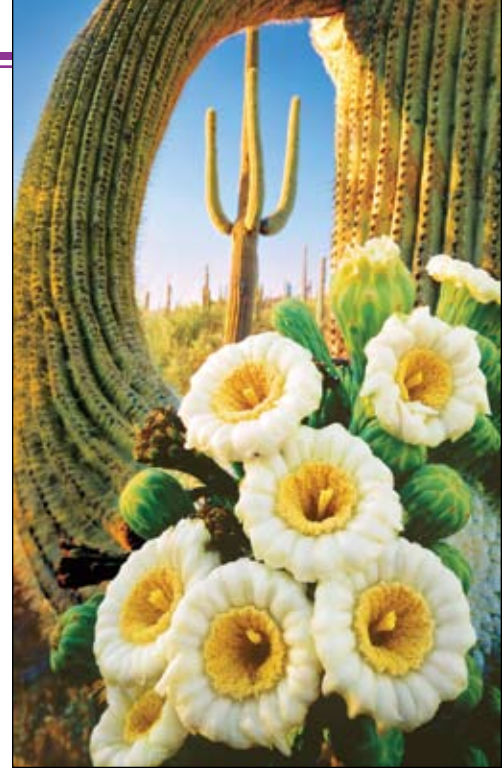

DAY

11 PALM SPRINGS: *Thursday.* A morning SIGHTSEEING TOUR showcases the best of this popular playground of the rich and famous. A local guide brings Palm Springs' vast history and Native American heritage to life and tells stories of the celebrities who have lived in this area, including the legendary Bob Hope. 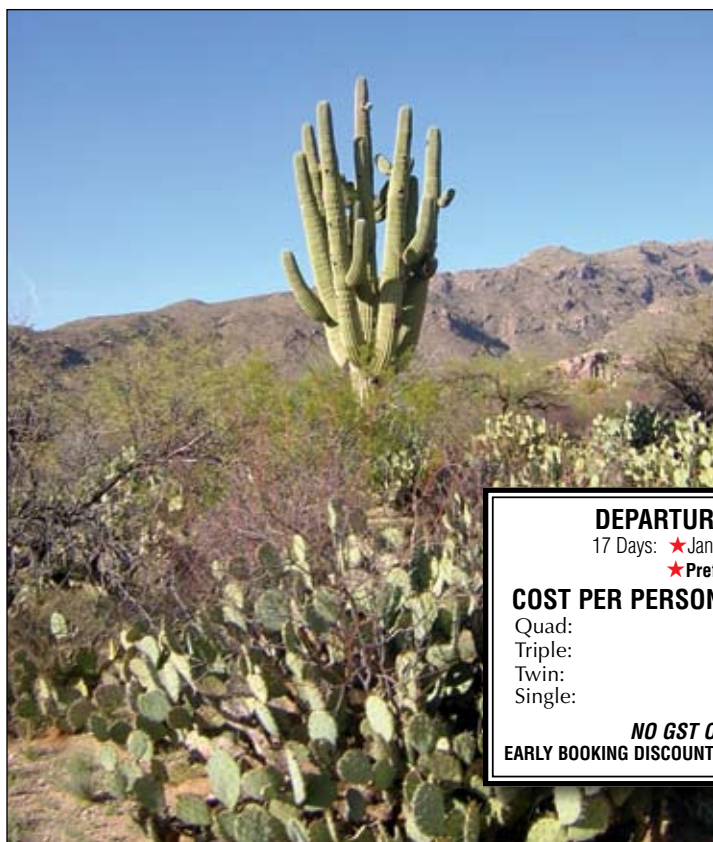
13 PALM SPRINGS AREA: *Saturday.* The morning will be devoted to an entertaining visit to THE LIVING DESERT – a unique facility that is a zoo, an endangered species conservation centre, botanical gardens, a natural history museum, a wilderness park, a nature preserve and an education centre. Don't miss the "Wildlife Wonders" live animal show, a fascinating wildlife presentation featuring desert mammals, reptiles and birds of prey. A "mall break" allows time for optional lunch and shopping prior to returning to the hotel.

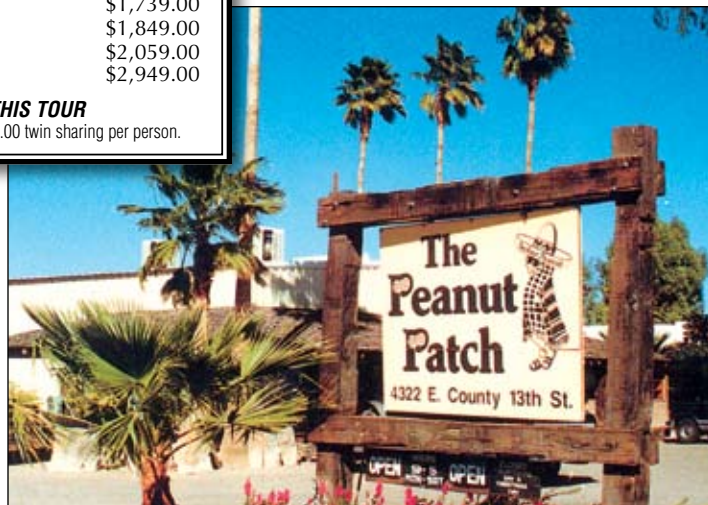
