

SPECTACULAR OREGON COAST

Join Nagel Tours on a fun-filled holiday to the scenic state of Oregon.

This memorable holiday combines the spectacular scenery of the Oregon Coast with the Portland Rose Festival. Highlights include a visit to the Columbia Gorge, Oregon Coast Aquarium, Oregon Dunes National Recreation area and reserved inside seating for the Grand Floral Parade.



DEPARTURE: Edmonton 7:00 a.m., Red Deer 9:00 a.m., Calgary 12:00 p.m., Ft. Macleod 1:45 p.m. (No pick-up in Lethbridge)

DAY

1 EDMONTON to CALGARY to BONNERS FERRY: *Monday.* All aboard for a tour that features the diverse scenery of Oregon and includes the Portland Rose Festival. Depart Edmonton, travel south via Red Deer, Calgary and Fort Macleod, then west through Pincher Creek to Cranbrook, B.C. Cross the Canadian/American border and arrive in Bonners Ferry for overnight.

2 BONNERS FERRY to THE DALLES: *Tuesday.* Travel through three American states all in one day: Idaho, Washington and Oregon. Your main destination for the day is the COLUMBIA GORGE DISCOVERY CENTER. After the tour overnight in the Dalles.

3 THE DALLES to NEWPORT: *Wednesday.* Today experience the soul of the Columbia, the grand river of the American West. Large dams and fish ladders add to the scenic route. Continue into Portland, where you swing west to the spectacular coast. Enjoy the scenery as you travel south on Highway #101. End your day in Newport, home of Oregon's largest fishing fleet. Visit the OREGON COAST AQUARIUM - a 30-acre site that provides a close-up glimpse of the fascinating marine and bird life inhabiting nearby waters.

4 NEWPORT to NORTH BEND: *Thursday.* Enjoy the scenery today as you travel the coastal route marked by endless bays and jagged rocks pounded by the ocean surf. After lunch in Florence enter the unusual landscape of the OREGON DUNES NATIONAL RECREATION AREA. This extremely scenic area contains huge hills and deep valleys of sand, several lakes and numerous "Ghost" forests created by the timeless action of the wind moving the massive sand dunes. Conclude your day in North Bend.

5 NORTH BEND to PORTLAND: *Friday.* Begin your day with a visit to the MYRTLEWOOD FACTORY where this intricately grained rare hardwood is turned into a surprising array of beautiful and useful products. Travel inland through

a low pass and the Coast Mountains and enter the lush and fertile beauty of the Willamette Valley, leading us into the Portland area.

6 PORTLAND: *Saturday.* The Portland Rose Festival has been rated as one of the top ten festivals in the world. Enjoy your reserved seats inside the Memorial Coliseum for the PRE-PARADE SHOW and the second largest ALL-FLORAL PARADE in the nation. Following the parade, the floats return to the ROSE QUARTER COMMONS where you may have a closer look at the flowers and workmanship.

7 PORTLAND to ABBOTSFORD: *Sunday.* This morning visit the INTERNATIONAL ROSE TEST GARDEN, the oldest garden of its kind in the U.S.A. Then our routing takes us past Olympia, Seattle and Bellingham. Stop at the Duty Free Store before re-entering Canada. Continue to Abbotsford, British Columbia for overnight.

8 ABBOTSFORD to THREE VALLEY GAP: *Monday.* Depart Fraser Valley, travel to Merritt, Kamloops and Three Valley Gap to enjoy your last evening together. Join your travelling companions for a hosted FAREWELL DINNER.

9 THREE VALLEY GAP TO CALGARY TO EDMONTON: *Tuesday.* Today's travelling provides a variety of unforgettable mountain scenery. Wind your way over the majestic ROGERS PASS. Enjoy a short DRIVING TOUR OF BANFF with lunch in Canmore. Make a mid-afternoon stop in Calgary and continue to Edmonton.
