

- HOME CITIES to HALIFAX:** *Tuesday.* Your *Exciting Holiday* begins as you board your jet and fly to Halifax. You will be transferred to your hotel which is ideally located in the downtown core of this vibrant and cosmopolitan urban centre. Meet your fellow travellers this evening at a WELCOME RECEPTION.
- HALIFAX to MONCTON:** *Wednesday.* Explore the BAY OF FUNDY and learn about the world's highest tides as you meander the colourful coastline. Enroute explore the JOGGINS FOSSIL CLIFFS, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. See magnificently exposed layers of rock revealing the world's most complete fossil record of life in the "Coal Age" of 300 million years ago. After crossing into New Brunswick, an unforgettable culinary experience awaits aboard a lobster boat where you savour a delicious LOBSTER DINNER. Arrive in New Brunswick's bilingual city of Moncton to check into your downtown hotel for the night. **Meals Include: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.**
- MONCTON to SAINT JOHN:** (2 nights) *Thursday.* Experience a true natural wonder this morning at HOPEWELL ROCKS on the Bay of Fundy coast. Marvel at these massive flower-pot shaped formations sculpted by the highest tides on the planet. Travel through FUNDY NATIONAL PARK on the southern New Brunswick coast to Canada's first incorporated city, Saint John. Enjoy a CITY TOUR including the REVERSING FALLS where twice daily the Bay of Fundy tides force the Saint John River to reverse its flow. Check into your harbourfront hotel in the heart of Saint John for a two-night stay. **Meals Include: Breakfast, Lunch.**
- SAINT JOHN AREA:** *Friday.* Enjoy a day trip to picturesque ST. ANDREWS BY-THE-SEA where the quaint charm of this coastal town is sure to captivate. After a WHALE WATCHING BOAT TOUR (weather permitting), the afternoon is yours to experience the friendly people, beautiful architecture, and rich marine life of this seaside gem at your own pace. **Meals Include: Breakfast, Lunch.**
- SAINT JOHN to DIGBY:** *Saturday.* FERRY back to Nova Scotia this morning. - DIGBY to HALIFAX:** *Sunday.* Travel the lush ANNAPOLIS VALLEY where you learn about the French Acadians who established their first settlement in the early 1600's. Learn about the designation of this area as a UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE where fact and fiction blend to reveal the romance of the LAND OF EVANGELINE. before crossing the world's longest continuous multi-span bridge, the CONFEDERATION BRIDGE, to Prince Edward Island for a two-night stay. Take in a theatre performance this evening by local entertainers at the CONFEDERATION CENTRE OF THE ARTS (a substitution may be necessary depending on the theatre schedule.) **Meals Include: Breakfast.**

9 PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND: Wednesday. This morning it's your choice: Enjoy a free morning in Canada's birthplace, Charlottetown or join a WALKING TOUR of the city. 
