
## SK AB

The five stages throughout the festival are packed with performances from 9am to 7pm. For those who like to stay into the late-night there are performers in select halls for after the Great Hall Concerts!


**TBA p.m. Included Main Stage Show #1 Bjøro Håland**. Bjøro Håland was born in Norway. When he turned 17, he immigrated to the USA

where he worked as a carpenter and sang in the local bars. He met his wife Liv in Brooklyn, and they moved back to Norway in 1966. His first recording was made in 1970. He now travels back and forth between the USA and his beloved native Norway.

- MINOT: Thursday. 7:00 p.m. Included Main Stage Show #2 Matt Vee and The Killer Vee's (Neil Diamond Tribute). Matt Vee, singer, guitarist, songwriter, recording artist and nephew of legendary 60s pop-star Bobby Vee. Matt tours internationally with his wife Julie Velline, and cousins and band-mates Jeff and Tommy Vee (sons of Bobby Vee) in various musical configurations. Most notably is Matt's production of "I Am, He Said" A Celebration of the Music of Neil Diamond, which has played for tens of thousands nationwide.
  - MINOT: Friday. Join our optional excursion to the SCANDINAVIAN HERITAGE PARK where buildings, statues, and monuments celebrate the heritage of Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden. Explore the full-scale Gol Stave Church, walk around the 27-foot tall Swedish Dala Horse, step inside a real Stabbur, and more. 1:00 p.m. Included Main Stage Show #3 Abbacadabra (ABBA Tribute). This team of highly trained vocalists and internationally known keyboardists, percussionists and




bassists recreate the sounds and sights of an ABBA show. The group's first show was at the El Dorado Resort and Casino in Reno, but they were soon playing to sold-out crowds around the country and on cruise lines such as Princess and Royal Caribbean. Fittingly, in 2007, they began performing in Europe, where ABBA first came to fame. The group covers 20 of ABBA's mega- hits, including "Mamma Mia," "Dancing Queen," "The Winner Takes It All," and "Take a Chance on Me." They are known for their attention to detail, from the sound to the clothing. Listening to them is like taking a step back in time when everyone was dancing.


- MINOT: Saturday. Savour that last taste of Scandinavian food and catch the entertainment on the final day of this year's Høstfest.

- 6 7 MINOT to SWIFT CURRENT: Sunday. Retrace your steps as you head towards home. Make a stop at the duty-free store and then re-enter Canada. Bid farewell to your fellow travellers from Saskatchewan. Return to Swift Current for overnight.
- 7 8 SWIFT CURRENT to CALGARY to EDMONTON: Monday. Return home with fond memories of your Høstfest experience and new friendships made.
